MINUTES

- 1. Call to Order: President Dr. Marion Hernon called the meeting to order a 6:35 p.m.
- 2. **Approval of Oct. 5 Minutes:** Moved, seconded, and carried, to approve the minutes as printed in the November issue of *Toothsayer*.
- 3. **Introduction of Guests:** Nancy Tupper recognized guests from UW School of Dentistry: Dr. Gary Chiodo, Dean; Dr. Sara Gordon, Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and professor of oral medicine; and Doug Day, Associate Director of Advancement & External Affairs.

- a) <u>UW Dental Alumni Association</u>: Doug Day provided an update on the school's Dental Alumni Association.
- b) <u>UW School of Dentistry Update</u>: President-Elect Dr. Will Nichols introduced Dr. Gary Chiodo, Dean of UW-SOD. Dr. Chiodo provided an update on the School of Dentistry. Highlights:
 - 2021 Fiscal year has ended with a positive revenue of about \$1.3M, which will allow the school to recruit and hire more faculty
 - Clinical production is minimum of 95% recovered and over 100% recovered in graduate clinics, with an increased in new patients and overall visits as well
 - Shoreline Community College Dental Hygiene Program is operating at UWSOD as of now and is revenue positive and has begun implementing a recall program
 - A hearty thank you was extended to all members for the MBDDS gift of \$1,000 towards the Shoreline program and it has been matched as part of the challenge grant through Delta Dental of Washington
 - Plan to increase enrollment back up to 25 hygiene students per year and transfer around 2,000 active patients from Shoreline to UWSOD
 - New SOD Research Graduate Program Director Robert Cornell, PhD, will be arriving at the new year; his focus is in genetic pathways in embryonic cells and adult stem cells and he currently is the PI for 3 NIH grants
